'Increase in cess on cigarette to escalate its smuggling'

New Delhi: Imposition of additional duty on cigarette by the government would increase pressure on the industry and will encourage its smuggling into India by

- illegal trade operators, the Tobacco Institute of India (TII) said on Saturday. While presenting the Union Budget for 2020-21, FM Nirmala Sitharaman proposed to increase the National Calamity Contingency Duty on
 - Calamity Contingency Duty on cigarettes, hookah, chewing tobacco, snuff and tobacco extracts and essence. "The increase in NCCD announced in the Budget and the
- resulting escalation in cigarette taxation leading to higher tax arbitrage will serve as a huge incentive to illegal cigarette trade operators, who target India as a preferred
- destination for smuggled cigarettes," TII said. PTI
