

80.1 Lakh foreign cigarettes seized at Mundra port

The Ahmedabad Zonal Unit of the Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (DRI) Friday seized a container with 80.1 lakh of foreign cigarettes – worth Rs 16 crore in the market – concealed in a consignment declared as readymade garments at the Mundra port.

The officers intercepted the container shipped from Cambodia's Phnom Penh Port.

It was destined for Hazira Port, a statement by DRI said, adding seized cigarette packets had the marking of 'Made in India'.
