

539 imported cigarette packs seized in Ajmer: Action against two firms; packets lacked statutory health warnings, violating COTPA Act **June 3, 2026**

Ajmer food safety officials raided two firms and seized 539 packets of imported cigarettes. The packets did not carry any statutory health warnings, officials said. The department will now file a case against the firms in court.



Acting on directions from the Commissionerate of Food Safety and Drug Control, Rajasthan, Jaipur, the Food Safety Department conducted raids under Section 7 of the COTPA Act at M/s Deepak General Store in Khari Kui and M/s Ghanshyam Brothers in Kavanduspura.

During the operation, officials seized imported cigarette packets found at the premises.

The raid was carried out by Food Safety Officers Ajay Moyal, Anand Kumar, Deepak Kumar and Rajendra Sharma, with assistance from staff member Rajkumar Indoriya.
