Myanmar-made cigarettes seized

GUWAHATI, June 7 - CID sleuths this morning seized 36 cartons of Myanmar-made cigarettes from a truck at Lokhra.

The truck was parked at a parking lot. The driver and the handyman apparently fled following the CID raid.

"The operation was conducted following a tip-off. The cartons were hidden beneath coal. Apparently the cigarettes were brought from Moreh and were bound for northern India," CID officials said. It is estimated that the cost of seized cigarettes could be around Rs 40 lakh.
